1 [TO SUBSTITUTE BILL No. 1] 2 3 Page 49-after line 5 Insert the following new section and 4 renumber as necessary: 5 6 "[GOVERNOR'S RESIDENCE STUDY] 7 8 Section 13. 9 10 (a) The state building commission shall review the security facility requirements of the Governor's residence and 11 the 12 buildings and grounds related to the residence, and authorize 13 modifications to non-personnel security measures for the 14 residence, buildings and grounds as it determines appropriate. 15 In authorizing modifications, the commission shall consider the 16 provisions of this section in regard to the potential 17 construction of a new governor's residence. 18 19 (b) The state building commission shall: 20 21 (i) Review potential locations available to construct 22 a new governor's residence, or to modify the current residence 23 or another existing building to serve as the governor's 24 residence; 25 26 (ii) Determine the potential cost for a new governor's 27 residence, including associated grounds and buildings, together 28 with necessary non-personnel security measures; 29 30 (iii) Study the feasibility of leasing a temporary facility to serve as the governor's residence until modification 31 32 or construction of a governor's residence is completed; 33 34 (iv) Determine estimated revenues to the state by the 35 sale of the current governor's residence and grounds; 36 37 (v) Propose a schedule for construction of a new 38 governor's residence, which may include modification of the 39 existing governor's residence or another existing building to 40 serve as a governor's residence. 41 42 If the state building commission determines that a (C) 43 viable location for a new governor's residence has been

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1 identified and that security or other issues make continued use of the current governor's residence not practical, it may 2 3 authorize negotiations to sell the current governor's residence 4 and grounds. The commission may enter into an agreement to sell 5 the residence and grounds or to provide a right of first refusal to a potential buyer, but any agreement shall be contingent upon 6 legislative appropriation of sufficient funds to construct a new 7 governor's residence enacted in the 2019 general session. 8 9

10 (d) The state building commission shall provide a report of 11 its actions and recommendations under subsections (b) and (c) of 12 this section to the management council of the legislature not 13 later than November 1, 2018.

15 There is appropriated four hundred thousand dollars (e) 16 (\$400,000.00) from the legislative stabilization reserve account 17 to the state building commission. This appropriation shall be 18 for the period beginning with the effective date of this section and ending June 30, 2020. This appropriation shall only be 19 expended for the purposes of this section. Notwithstanding any 20 21 other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended 22 for any other purpose and any 23 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2020. 24 This 25 appropriation shall not be included in the state building 26 commission's 2021-2022 standard biennial budget request.". 27
