If the negotiation reveals viable and 14 fiscally advantageous options for expansion of medical assistance, the director, with the approval of the governor, is 15 16 authorized to pursue necessary and prudent waivers and state 17 plan amendments for the expansion to occur. The negotiation and any waivers and state plan amendments shall be subject to the 18 19 following: 20 21 The medical assistance expansion shall include a (i) 22 work, volunteerism or educational requirement for beneficiaries, 23 consistent with any exceptions required by federal law; 24 25 To the maximum extent possible, any necessary (ii) amendments and waivers shall be limited to the funds made 26 available by the federal government for the expansion of medical 27 28 assistance: 29 30 (iii) The medical assistance expansion shall include 31 premium assistance for eligible higher income individuals to enable their enrollment in a qualified health plan through a 32 33 federal health insurance exchange or an employer sponsored group 34 health insurance plan; 35 36 The expansion program shall include a cost-(iv) 37 sharing requirement, as authorized under federal law, for 38 eligible moderate income individuals;

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1 (v) To the maximum extent possible, premiums and out-2 3 of-pocket expenses shall be established at levels that will 4 ensure no fiscal impact to the state of Wyoming; 5 6 (vi) Initial and continuing income eligibility 7 standards shall be structured, to the extent possible, to avoid creating disincentives for a beneficiary to increase the 8 9 beneficiary's household income; 10 11 The expansion program shall include wellness (vii) 12 benefits and waive cost-sharing requirements for these benefits; 13 and 14 15 The expansion program shall include cost-(viii) 16 sharing incentives for beneficiaries who attain specified 17 uniform standards of health, including completion of an approved 18 annual health risk assessment to identify unhealthv 19 characteristics such as alcohol or substance disorders, tobacco 20 use, obesity and immunization deficiencies. 21 22 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the 23 department of health shall have spending authority to the extent 24 necessary to implement this section. 25 26 This section is repealed effective on the date that (C) 27 the federal government informs the state of Wyoming that it is 28 no longer eligible to receive the federal medical assistance 29 percentage offered on January 1, 2018 to states providing 30 coverage for all persons described under 42 U.S.C. 31 1396a(a)(10)(A)(i)(VIII). 32 33 (d) This section constitutes the Legislature's approval for 34 expansion of medical assistance pursuant to 2013 Wyoming Session 35 Laws, Chapter 116, Section 5. 36 37 This section is effective immediately.".
