

FISCAL NOTE

The fiscal impact to the judicial system is indeterminable due to an unknown number of cases.

The Department of Corrections states there are no current measures that can provide an accurate estimate of the number of individuals sentenced pursuant to the bill. Each year of incarceration, per inmate, will cost the State approximately \$41,537, including medical costs. The cost for community supervision, per offender, is approximately \$2,000 per year.
