Anticipated Expenditure increase
HIGHWAY FUND

Up to \$175,000

Source of expenditure increase:

The bill specifies statutory requirements for individual vehicles to change lanes and/or slow down for emergency and other public and maintenance vehicles parked on the side of a road. The Department of Transportation (WYDOT) states the bill will require changing notification language on roadside signs along applicable highways around the state.

Assumptions:

WYDOT estimates it will cost between \$140,000 and \$175,000 from the HIGHWAY FUND to overlay new language onto current large signs statewide. WYDOT states the number of signs that would need to be revised include the following:

- 23 large signs along interstate highways.
- 92 large signs along two-lane highways.
- 3 large signs along multi-lane highways.

All signs would be changed no later than FY 2019.

The expenditure increase reflected above could be considered an administrative cost. However, for simplicity and to follow consistent practice on legislation of this type, it is included on the fiscal note.
