Source of revenue increase:

The sale of additional resident and nonresident mountain goat licenses as a result of a general mountain goat season.

## Assumptions:

If the Wyoming Game and Fish Commission decided to enact general license hunting seasons in select mountain goat hunt areas, licenses would be offered over-the-counter and would be unlimited in number. The Game and Fish estimates participation would be minimal in these areas due to difficult terrain and very low densities of mountain goats. Game and Fish Department estimates a revenue increase in each fiscal year assuming that ten general licenses would be sold at an 80/20 ratio resident/non-resident. A resident mountain goat license is \$152 and a nonresident mountain goal license is \$2,162.
