Source of expenditure increase (decrease):

Costs for the Water Development Commission to conduct studies regarding the feasibility of providing instream flows would become the responsibility of the Wyoming Game and Fish Commission.

Assumptions:

It is assumed there would be one study each fiscal year at an average cost of \$30,000 per year.

It is assumed the Water Development Office will continue to retain the services of professional engineers to conduct the instream flow feasibility studies with the cost of these studies being funded by the Game and Fish Commission.

The expenditure increase and decrease reflected above could be considered an administrative cost. However, for simplicity and to follow consistent practice on legislation of this type, it is included on the fiscal note.
