Description of Appropriation:

The bill's appropriation will be used to hire four positions outlined in the bill: one administrator (an attorney), two investigators (one senior and one investigator), and one legal support specialist. Each position will also require support services and information technology resources.

Assumptions:

There will be one-time office set-up and support service costs including furniture, computer workstations, and a vehicle. Ongoing support and information technology costs include travel costs, office supplies, and communication devices (cell phones and desk phones). In FY 2019, the Attorney General's Office would purchase or work with the Department of Enterprise Technology Services to establish software and a fraud hotline/website at an estimated cost of \$20,000.
