FISCAL NOTE

No significant fiscal or personnel impact.

Nonresident tuition rates for the seven community colleges are already at least 50 percent more than resident tuition rates. None of the seven community colleges currently have nonresident fee schedules. Therefore, this bill would have no fiscal impact to revenues at the seven community colleges.

Current and anticipated tuition rates at the University of Wyoming consistently involve nonresident tuition rates which are more than 10% greater than resident tuition. As such, the bill's requirement that non-resident tuition levels must be 10% higher than resident tuition would have no impact to revenues at the University of Wyoming.
