A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to public health; clarifying that a minor
2 can include a person that has reached the age of majority
3 if the person is dependent on a parent or legal guardian
4 for medical care; making conforming changes; and providing
5 for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-7-1901(a) by creating a new
10 paragraph (viii) and 35-7-1902(f) are amended to read:

12 **35-7-1901. Definitions.**

14 (a) As used in this article:

15

1 (viii) "Minor" includes a person:

2

3 (A) Under the age of majority; or

4

5 (B) Who has reached the age of majority if
6 the person is disabled and dependent on a parent for
7 medical care.

9 **35-7-1902. Hemp extract registration cards.**

10

11 (f) A registration card issued under subsection (a)
12 or (b) of this section is valid for one (1) year and is
13 renewable if, at the time of renewal, the registrant meets
14 the requirements of subsection (a) or (b) of this section.
15 A card issued pursuant to subsection (b) of this section
16 remains valid after the minor reaches the age of majority
17 until the card expires or is replaced by a card issued
18 pursuant to subsection (a) of this section or renewed under
19 subsection (b) of this section if the person remains a
20 minor as defined in W.S. 35-7-1901(a)(viii).

1 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2018.
