- 1 AN ACT relating to underground public utility facilities;
- 2 modifying requirements for architectural and engineering
- 3 plans to include information concerning underground
- 4 facilities; specifying information required to be provided
- 5 by operators of underground facilities; and providing for
- 6 an effective date.

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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10 **Section 1.** W.S. 37-12-302(b) is amended to read:

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- 12 37-12-302. Notice of excavation by excavator;
- 13 information to be supplied upon notice; exceptions;
- 14 penalty.

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1 (b) Any person requiring or designing preparing architectural or engineering drawings or designs that call 2 3 for excavation in or adjacent to any public street, alley, 4 sidewalk or right-of-way dedicated to public use or a utility easement shall obtain information from operators, 5 as to the nature, location, and depth if known, of 6 underground facilities. If the information is not 7 8 available, the person requiring or designing architectural 9 or engineering drawings that call for excavation shall 10 determine at their expense the nature and location of the 11 underground facilities. The person requiring or designing 12 architectural or engineering drawings that call for 13 excavation and shall make the information and location a 14 part of the plan by which the excavators operate. Except 15 as otherwise provided in this subsection, operators shall 16 upon request make available all records showing the location of underground facilities within ten (10) business 17 days of the request and shall at the operator's expense use 18 19 reasonable care to mark the location of underground 20 facilities in the same manner as provided in subsection (d) 21 of this section. An operator may require additional information from any person making a request under this 22 23 subsection including information concerning the person's

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criminal background history or professional credentials. An operator may deny unreasonable or illegitimate requests made under this subsection and shall notify the person of the reason for denial within ten (10) business days of the request.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2018.
