A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the child health insurance program;

- 2 authorizing the program to be provided by the state or by a
- 3 private insurance company; amending charge and collection
- 4 limits; discontinuing the CHIP health benefits plan
- 5 committee; making conforming amendments; and providing for
- 6 an effective date.

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-25-103, 35-25-106(a) and (b) and
- 11 35-25-108(b)(i) are amended to read:

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- 13 35-25-103. Child health insurance program
- 14 eligibility; services by department or private health
- 15 insurance.

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2 (a) Subject to approval of the state plan by the 3 United States secretary of health and human services, and 4 subject to available state and federal funding the department shall provide a health insurance plan offered 5 through a private insurance company licensed by the 6 insurance commissioner to write insurance in Wyoming for an 7 8 eligible child whose monthly gross family income is not 9 more than one hundred eighty-five percent (185%) of the 10 federal poverty level, until July 1, 2005, and thereafter, 11 whose monthly gross family income is not more than two 12 hundred percent (200%) of the federal poverty level. 13 child who is determined eligible to receive benefits under 14 this section shall remain eligible for twelve (12) months 15 as long as the child resides in the state of Wyoming and 16 has not yet attained nineteen (19) years of age. A child's 17 eligibility to receive benefits under this act shall be 18 redetermined on an annual basis. A simplified application 19 process, which includes minimum eligibility requirements, 20 shall be provided throughout the state at various public 21 and private establishments approved by the department of health. To be determined eligible to receive benefits under 22 23 this section, a child shall not be eligible under the

1 Wyoming Medical Assistance and Services Act, shall not have

2 been covered under another health insurance plan for a

3 minimum of one (1) month prior to application for coverage

4 under this act or, upon birth, the child would not

5 otherwise be covered by a public or private health

6 insurance plan. Eligibility under this section shall be

7 determined by the department of health or its designee.

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9 (b) The child health insurance plan required by 10 subsection (a) of this section shall be provided either 11 through a private health insurance company licensed by the 12 insurance commissioner to write insurance in Wyoming or by 13 the department of health's division responsible for 14 administering the Medicaid program. The department's 15 division shall be used to provide the insurance plan only 16 if it can provide the plan at a lower cost than can a 17 qualified private insurance company or if use of the 18 division will otherwise accrue more benefits to the state 19 than will use of a private insurance company.

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(c) A medical provider who accepts payment for
zervices provided under this section shall not charge or
attempt to collect payments in excess of a rate schedule

1 established by the department or in excess of rates

2 negotiated with a private health insurance company who is

3 offering child health insurance pursuant to this act.

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8 (a) If the child health insurance plan required by 9 W.S. 35-25-103 will be provided through a private health 10 insurance company, the department shall publish notice of issue a request for proposals from qualified insurers to 11 provide a health insurance plan for children insured under 12 13 W.S. 35-25-103 of this act. The department and shall award 14 the contract for this service to an insurer based on price, 15 the provision of benchmark required services determined 16 pursuant to W.S. 35-25-105(c), and other factors listed in the department's request for proposals. The A contract for 17 18 health insurance awarded under this section shall contain 19 provisions with respect to exclusions from coverage for 20 preexisting conditions that are no more restrictive than those described in 42 U.S.C. 1397bb(b)(1)(B)(ii). The 21 contract shall include provisions for changes in terms and 22 23 conditions and for rebidding in case major changes are

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needed. The department shall have the right to rebid the 1 2 contract after two (2) years. 3 4 (b) Biennially, the department may allow the 5 contractor providing child health insurance pursuant to subsection (a) of this section to adjust the price charged 6 for the coverage, but if the price is increased, the 7 8 department may, after public notice, rebid the contract. 9 10 35-25-108. Implementation; duties; restrictions on 11 the department of health. 12 13 The department shall not implement: (b) 14 15 The program under this act until a state (i) 16 plan has been approved by the United States secretary of 17 health and human services or, for any modified plan, until 18 the modified plan has been approved if the modifications 19 require the approval of the United States secretary of 20 health and human services; and
