- 15 machinery and provisions for the construction, major

maintenance and renovation of every state, county, 1 2 municipal, community college district or school district 3 institution: 4 5 (i) Shall contain the words "preference hereby given to materials, supplies, agricultural products, 6 equipment, machinery and provisions produced, manufactured 7 8 or grown in Wyoming, or supplied by a resident of the state, quality being equal to articles offered by the 9 10 competitors outside of the state";-11 (ii) May specify suggested brands or 12 13 manufacturers, provided that similar materials that meet or 14 exceed specifications shall be accepted as substitute 15 materials for the suggested brands or manufacturers. Unless 16 an exception is made by the state construction department and approved by the state building commission prior to 17 18 submitting a request, specified materials that are not 19 currently available to any Wyoming resident suppliers shall 20 not be used in any bid or proposal in a manner which would 21 exclude Wyoming resident suppliers from submitting a bid or

proposal. Any exception under this paragraph shall be

reported to the joint appropriations committee. As used in

1 this paragraph, "materials" means as defined in W.S.

2 16-6-105(a)(ii).

4 Section 2. This act shall only apply to

5 advertisements for bids made or requests for bids or

6 proposals issued on or after the effective date of this
