- 1 AN ACT relating to municipalities and counties; amending
- 2 powers which may be exercised by a housing authority;
- 3 authorizing the appointment of additional commissioners to
- 4 a regional housing authority as specified; authorizing
- 5 staggered terms for regional housing authority
- 6 commissioners; and providing for an effective date.

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 15-10-115(a) (intro) and 15-10-116(b),
- 11 (c) (intro), (iii) and (f) are amended to read:

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- 13 15-10-115. Powers which may be exercised by
- 14 municipality or county or by authority.

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(a) A municipality or county may exercise its housing 1 2 project powers or, if its governing body determines such 3 action to be in the public interest, may establish a 4 housing authority pursuant to W.S. 15-10-116 and elect to have these its housing project powers exercised by it the 5 6 housing authority as provided in this subsection. A housing authority so established is vested with all shall 7 8 only have the powers conferred by this chapter on municipalities and counties as authorized by the governing 9 10 body of the municipality or county, except that the 11 following functions must shall be exercised by 12 municipality or county itself: 13 14 15-10-116. Housing authority; creation; form; 15 commissioners; proceedings; officers, agents; proof of 16 establishment. 17 18 (b) If the governing body of each of two (2) or more municipalities or counties, or combinations 19 20 municipalities and counties, has made the finding prescribed in W.S. 15-10-102, has taken the necessary 21 action to cooperate with one another and has elected as 22 provided in W.S. 15-10-115 to have its housing project 23

1 powers exercised by a housing authority created for all the

2 municipalities or counties so joining or cooperating, a

3 public body corporate and politic to be known as a regional

4 housing authority shall thereupon exist for all these

5 municipalities or counties or combinations thereof.

6 Additional municipalities or counties may elect to have the

7 regional authority exercise their powers as provided in

8 W.S. 15-10-115 upon taking the actions specified in this

9 subsection, and with the consent, by resolution, of all the

10 municipalities and counties having elected to have their

11 powers exercised by the regional authority.

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13 (c) If a housing authority has been created and

14 authorized by a municipality or county to exercise its

15 housing project powers as provided in W.S. 15-10-115,

16 commissioners of the authority shall be appointed as

17 follows:

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19 (iii) In the case of a regional housing

20 authority, the governing body of each municipality and

21 county participating shall appoint one (1) person as a

22 commissioner of the authority. If only two (2)

23 municipalities or counties or a combination thereof are

participating, the commissioners appointed by the governing 1 2 bodies of the participants shall appoint one (1) additional 3 commissioner unless the governing bodies of the 4 participants agree to each appoint one (1) additional 5 commissioner, in which case the four (4) commissioners 6 appointed by the two (2) governing bodies shall, upon authorization of the governing bodies, appoint one (1) 7 additional commissioner. If three (3) or four (4) 8 municipalities or counties or a combination thereof are 9 10 participating, the commissioners appointed by the governing 11 bodies of the participants may, upon authorization of a 12 majority of the governing bodies, appoint additional 13 commissioners provided that the authority shall not exceed 14 a total of five (5) commissioners. The commissioners of a regional authority shall be appointed for terms of five (5) 15 16 years, except that all vacancies shall be filled for the 17 unexpired term and upon formation of the authority, the 18 governing bodies of the participants may, with unanimous 19 consent, stagger the initial terms of the commissioners; 20 21 (f) In any suit, action or proceeding involving the validity or enforcement of or relating to any contract of 22 the authority, an authority is conclusively deemed to be 23

1 established and authorized to transact business and

2 exercise its powers upon proof of compliance with the

3 provisions of paragraphs paragraph (c)(i) or (ii) of this

4 section, as the case may be. A copy of the resolutions

5 required to be adopted by the governing body electing to

6 have its housing project powers exercised by a housing

7 authority as provided in W.S. 15-10-115 shall be filed with

8 the clerk. A copy of the resolution duly certified by the

9 clerk is admissible in evidence in any suit, action or

10 proceeding.

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12 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon

13 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

14 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

15 Constitution.
