1 2 (i) While operating or driving a vehicle 3 violation of W.S. 10-6-103, 31-5-233 or 41-13-206, he 4 causes the death of another person and the violation is the 5 proximate cause of the death; or 6 (ii) He operates or drives a vehicle in a 7 8 reckless manner, and his conduct is the proximate cause of 9 the death of another person; - or 10 11 (iii) While operating or driving a vehicle in 12 violation of W.S. 31-5-237, he causes the death of another 13 person and the violation is the proximate cause of death. 14 15 31-5-237.
