

1 results related to schools on the Wind River Indian Reservation, traveling distance
2 between schools in Fremont county to other nearby K-12 schools serving similar-aged
3 populations, the manner in which reimbursements for transportation or special
4 education are incorporated into the calculation of state payments in accordance
5 with W.S. 21-4-601 and student performance and school accountability results under
6 W.S. 21-4-601 for schools on the Wind River Indian Reservation.

8 3. The department of education shall report to the joint education interim
9 committee and the joint appropriations committee not later than October 1, 2018
10 regarding the national certification incentive under W.S. 21-7-501(a) through (d),
11 compliance with current statute, administrative structure and historic annual costs
12 by budget series and purpose, payments provided for under W.S. 21-7-501(a) through
13 (d), and any expenditures toward the national certification incentive not
14 specifically authorized under W.S. 21-7-501 and recommended changes to statute.

16 4. Up to fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) from any appropriation to the
17 department under this section is authorized to be expended by the department during
18 school years 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 to pay for processing costs for Wyoming
19 poultry, lamb, pork, beef or bison donated to a school district to be used in school
20 lunches. Expenditures authorized in this footnote shall be made only if an equal
21 amount of funding has been contributed by a local school district for the processing
22 costs of the donated Wyoming poultry, lamb, pork, beef or bison. The department
23 shall endeavor to provide funding to as many school districts as possible.
24

25 5. Of this general fund appropriation, one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00)
26 shall be distributed to establish a pilot principal education program in Sheridan
27 County School District #2 as a component of the statewide system of support. The
28 department shall distribute these funds to the school district on or before July
29 1, 2019. Sheridan County School District #2 shall use these funds to train Wyoming
30 school principals and provide a report on the program to the joint education interim
31 committee by June 30, 2020."
