(ii) An assessment of any attempts made by insurance companies to establish service rates with air ambulance service providers and whether insurance companies routinely deny air ambulance service claims submitted for services rendered;

(iii) An analysis of the costs and benefits of an expansion;

Section 2.

This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.". KINSKEY, AGAR, KOST

(iv) Any necessary federal waiver, state plan amendment or other agreement, which must be approved by the United States department of health and human services, to make Medicaid coverage of air ambulance services available to all Wyoming residents;

- (v) Identification of the most practical and effective structure of Medicaid coverage that would provide benefits for air ambulance services at the lowest and most reasonable cost;
- (vi) The possibility of making Medicaid coverage for air ambulance services retroactive;
- (vii) Identification of any program administered by the state of Wyoming, including the state employees and officials group insurance and Wyoming workers' compensation, that provides or otherwise covers air ambulance services and identification of strategies or approaches for transitioning to possible Medicaid coverage;
- (viii) Analysis of probable payment rates including possible financial risk to Wyoming residents and potential cost sharing requirements;
- (ix) Identification of any statutory changes necessary for expanding the Medicaid program to cover air ambulance services as specified by this act;
- (x) Identification of any funding changes or appropriations necessary for expanding the Medicaid program to cover air ambulance services as specified by this act.
- (xi) Other issues the working group determines relevant or prudent to consider.
- (d) The working group shall report its findings and recommendations to the joint labor, health and social services interim committee not later than August 1, 2019. The committee shall consider the recommendations and may develop and sponsor any legislation it deems appropriate for consideration by the legislature.
