Jurisdiction over mixed martial arts and boxing 32 matches and licenses; power of municipalities. 33 34 The board shall have sole direction, management, control of, and 35 jurisdiction over, all mixed martial arts and boxing matches to be conducted, held or given within the state. No mixed martial arts 36 37 or boxing match shall be conducted, held or given within the state except pursuant to a license granted by the board and in accordance 38 with the provisions of this chapter and the rules and regulations 39 40 of the board. Every license shall be subject to such rules as the 41 board may prescribe. The board may, at its discretion, issue and 42 for cause revoke, deny or suspend a license to conduct, hold or 43 give a mixed martial arts or boxing match. The board shall have 44 full power and authority to limit the number of mixed martial arts

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and boxing matches to be held or given by any person, club, organization or corporation in this state. No provision of this chapter shall prevent any incorporated city or town from prohibiting by ordinance any mixed martial arts <u>or boxing</u> match, provided that no match shall be held other than in compliance with this chapter.

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33-48-106. License application; fee and bond.

10 Application for a license to conduct mixed martial arts and boxing 11 matches shall be in writing, shall be addressed to the board and 12 shall be verified by the individual promoter or by an officer of 13 the club, organization or corporation on whose behalf the 14 application is made. The application shall be accompanied by a fee as established by the board in accordance with W.S. 33-1-201. 15 16 The application shall show that the club, organization or 17 corporation has been in existence not less than thirty (30) days. 18 Before any license is issued under this chapter to any person, 19 club, organization or corporation, the applicant shall file with 20 the state treasurer a bond in an amount established by the board, 21 not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), with good and 22 sufficient surety, conditioned for the faithful performance of the 23 conditions of this chapter.

25 33-48-107. Report of person, club, organization or 26 corporation; admission fee to be paid.

(a) Every person, club, organization or corporation which exercises any of the privileges conferred by this chapter shall within seventy-two (72) hours after the determination of every match:

(ii) Pay to the board a fee of five percent (5%) of its total gross receipts from the sale of tickets of admission and admission fees to any mixed martial arts <u>or boxing</u> match.

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33-48-109. Amateur matches; exempt boxing matches.

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39 (a) Whenever an amateur mixed martial arts match is held by any person, club, organization or corporation, and the match is 40 not for pecuniary profit, the license fee and bond provisions of 41 W.S. 33-48-106, the reporting and fee provisions of W.S. 33-48-42 107, the presence of a board member and the deputy or inspector 43 44 provisions of W.S. 33-48-110 shall not apply. The match shall, 45 however, be subject to all other provisions of this chapter and 46 the rules and regulations of the board. 47

(b) Whenever a boxing match is held by any person, club, 1 2 organization or corporation, and the match is not for pecuniary 3 profit or there are less than two hundred fifty (250) tickets available to be sold for the match, the license fee and bond 4 5 provisions of W.S. 33-48-106, the reporting and fee provisions of 6 W.S. 33-48-107, the presence of a board member and the deputy or inspector provisions of W.S. 33-48-110 shall not apply. The match 7 shall, however, be subject to all other provisions of this chapter 8 9 and the rules and regulations of the board.

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33-48-111. Rules for conduct of matches.

(a) The board shall promulgate rules and regulations
regarding the conduct of matches not inconsistent with this chapter
or the unified rules of mixed martial arts <u>and the unified rules</u>
<u>of boxing</u> adopted by the association of boxing commissions.

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18 (b) No betting or wagering at any mixed martial arts or boxing match shall be permitted by any person directly associated 19 20 with the mixed martial arts or boxing match, including the contestants, spectators and members of the club or organization, 21 before, after or during any match, in or around the premises where 22 the match is held. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed 23 to prohibit betting or wagering as may be allowed by law away from 24 25 the premises where the match is held, or to authorize betting or 26 wagering otherwise prohibited by law.

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33-48-112. Examination by physician.

Each contestant shall be examined not more than twelve (12) hours prior to a mixed martial arts <u>or boxing</u> match by a physician who has been licensed to practice in Wyoming and who has been designated by the board. The physician shall certify in writing, over his signature, as to the contestant's physical condition to engage in the match. The physician's compensation shall be provided by the individual promoter or entity unless otherwise agreed.

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33-48-113. Referees.

40 No person shall act as a referee to a mixed martial arts <u>or boxing</u> 41 match without a certificate granted by the board. The board is 42 authorized to grant certificates to competent referees upon the 43 application and the payment of an annual fee as established by the 44 board in accordance with W.S. 33-1-201 and the board may revoke 45 any certificate granted to any referee for cause as the board may 46 deem sufficient.

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33-48-114. Penalty for contestants violating rules of board.

3 (a) In addition to any penalty imposed under W.S. 33-48-117, 4 any contestant who shall be found to be in violation of any rule 5 or regulation of the board shall be penalized as follows:

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7 (i) For the first offense he shall be restrained by 8 order of the board from participating in any mixed martial arts or 9 <u>boxing</u> match to be held or given by any person, club, organization 10 or corporation licensed to give or hold any mixed martial arts or 11 <u>boxing</u> match for a period of not less than three (3) months nor 12 more than one (1) year at the discretion of the board; 13

14 (ii) For a second offense he shall be disqualified from 15 further admission or participation in any mixed martial arts <u>or</u> 16 <u>boxing</u> match, held or given by any person, club, organization or 17 corporation licensed under this chapter.

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33-48-116. Weights and classes.

The weights and classes of mixed martial arts <u>and boxing</u> participants and the rules and regulations of mixed martial arts <u>and boxing</u> shall be the same as the weights and classes and rules and regulations adopted by the association of boxing commissions in the unified rules of mixed martial arts <u>and the unified rules</u> <u>of boxing</u>, except as otherwise provided in this chapter.
