6 "(iv) Implements an education accountability system
7 equivalent to the public school education accountability system as
8 provided in the Wyoming Accountability in Education Act through
9 all of the following:

10
11 (A) Enter into a contract with the state department of
12 education to have the students attending the private school take
13 the statewide assessment. The private school shall ensure that its
14 students take the statewide assessment in an equivalent manner to
15 students in the public school system. The private school shall pay
16 the associated actual costs;

18 (B) Use indicators contained in W.S. 21-2-204(c) to
19 measure school level performance;

20
21 (C) Establish long term and interim performance targets
22 equivalent to those established for a similar public school as
23 provided by W.S. 21-2-204(e);

24
25 (D) Compile, evaluate and determine the target levels
26 for an overall school performance rating and for indicator level
27 performance in a manner equivalent to a similar public school as
28 provided by W.S. 21-2-204(f);

29
30 (E) Annually compute and report to the department of
31 education the overall school performance rating and other
32 performance determinations.

34 (v) When providing a high school education, require students
35 to complete the following courses in order to graduate;

37 (A) Four (4) school years of English;

39 (B) Three (3) school years of mathematics;

41 (C) Three (3) school years of science, one (1) year of
42 which may be satisfied by one (1) year of computer science; and

1 (D) Three (3) school years of social studies, including
2 history, American government and economic systems and
3 institutions, provided business instructors may instruct classes
