Page 1-line 7 8 9 Page 1-lines 12 and 13 Delete entirely. 10 11 Page 2-lines 1 through 23 Delete entirely. 12 13 Page 3-lines 1 through 5 Delete entirely and insert: 14 15 "(a) Activities of the office shall be directed by a management council composed of the president, vice president, 16 17 majority and minority floor leaders leader or their respective designees of the senate, plus two (2) four (4) senators, or their 18 respective designees, selected at large; not more than one (1) of 19 which shall be from the same political party as the president; and 20 21 the speaker, speaker pro tempore, majority and minority floor 22 leaders leader or their respective designees of the house plus two (2) four (4) representatives, or their respective designees, 23 24 selected at large., not more than one (1) of which shall be from 25 the same political party as the speaker. The two (2) senators selected at large shall be selected by caucus of the two (2) major 26 27 political parties in the senate, meeting separately, and the (2) representatives selected at large shall be selected by caucus of 28 the two (2) major political parties of the house, meeting 29 separately. These eight (8) at large members shall be selected 30 31 randomly from among members of the house and senate using a process 32 established by the management council. These twelve (12) members shall select One (1) additional member shall be selected at large 33 34 from the house of which the chairman of the management council is 35 not a member- using the random selection process established by 36 the management council, provided that the member at large shall 37 not be from the same party as the chairman of the management council. Chairmanship of the management council shall be rotated 38 39 between the house and senate after each two (2) year session so 40 that the chairman shall not be from the same house as the chairman who served for the preceding legislative term. The members of the 41 management council shall be the legislative representatives in 42 43 directing the day-to-day functions of the office and the entire

1 membership of the legislature shall have the ultimate control and 2 supervision over policy of the office.

4 (b) Succeeding management councils shall be composed of said 5 officers serving the thirteen (13) members specified under 6 subsection (a) of this section during the legislative session. 7 Membership on the management council shall terminate upon qualification of a member's successor or upon the termination of 8 9 the member's position held within his respective chamber, whichever first occurs. Vacancies occurring by reason of refusal 10 11 or inability to serve during a period when the legislature is or 12 is not in session, or for any other reason, shall be filled by a 13 member of the body through appointment by a majority vote of the 14 remaining members on the council of his political party or random 15 selection for at large members, as applicable. The council shall keep minutes of its meetings, which shall be available to all 16 17 members of the legislature upon request. Any member of the 18 legislature shall have the right to attend any of the meetings of 19 the management council and may present his views on any relevant 20 subject. 21

"Section 2. Not later than December 1, 2020, the management council shall prescribe the random selection process to select at large management council members pursuant to W.S. 28-8-102(a), as amended by this act.
