FISCAL NOTE

No significant fiscal or personnel impact.

Nonresident tuition rates for the seven community colleges are already at least 50 percent more than resident tuition rates. None of the seven community colleges currently have nonresident fee schedules. Therefore, this bill would have no fiscal impact to revenues at the seven community colleges.

Current and anticipated tuition rates at the University of Wyoming consistently involve nonresident tuition rates which are more than 20% greater than resident tuition. As such, the bill's requirement that nonresident tuition levels must be 20% higher than resident tuition would have no fiscal impact to revenues at the University of Wyoming.
