Source of expenditure increase:

The Department of Transportation is currently in the process of redesigning the Wyoming Driver's license and identification cards with a projected completion date and new credential to be issued in the fall of 2019. In order to meet this deadline, the content of the cards needs to be determined by January 24, 2019. With that in mind, if this legislation were to pass, the Department of Transportation would incur an additional \$25,000 in expenses for card design and implementation.

In addition, The Department of Transportation would incur an additional cost of \$55,000 in order to make changes to the current existing cards that would be issued between July 1, 2019 and the roll-out of the newly designed driver's license and identification cards.

There would be an estimated \$1,000 in programming changes to the Revenue Information System (RIS) to pass the information to the vendor for card production.

The expenditure increase reflected above could be considered an administrative cost. However, for simplicity and to follow consistent practice on legislation of this type, it is included on the fiscal note.
