## FISCAL NOTE

The fiscal impact, in the form of increased revenue to community colleges and increased expenditures for Wyoming community colleges and the Wyoming Community College Commission (WCCC), is indeterminable.

The WCCC indicates community colleges would not start offering baccalaureate degree programs until January 2022 at the earliest due to accreditation and program approval processes.

The WCCC estimates a community college would experience both increased tuition revenue and increased expenditures as a result of offering baccalaureate degree programs, however, the amounts are indeterminable. The WCCC also indicates increased expenditures in the form of additional state aid in the WCCC's standard budget due to college enrollment for baccalaureate degree programs. However, this expenditure increase is indeterminable.
