5 (c) The sale, transfer, purchase, delivery, taxation, manufacture, ownership, transportation, storage, use and 6 possession of firearms, weapons and ammunition shall be 7 authorized, regulated and prohibited by the state, and 8 9 regulation thereof is preempted by the legislature of the 10 state of Wyoming. Except as authorized by W.S. 15-1-103(a)(xviii) and 21-3-132, no state agency or entity, 11 12 city, town, county, political subdivision or any other entity 13 shall authorize, regulate or prohibit the sale, transfer, 14 purchase, delivery, taxation, manufacture, ownership, transportation, storage, use, carrying or possession of 15 16 firearms, weapons, accessories, components or ammunition 17 except as specifically provided by this chapter law. Nothing in this section shall prohibit a private property owner from 18 19 regulating or restricting firearms, weapons or ammunition on 20 his private property. This section shall not affect zoning or 21 other ordinances which encompass firearms businesses along 22 with other businesses. Zoning and other ordinances which are 23 designed for the purpose of restricting or prohibiting the

1 sale, purchase, transfer or manufacture of firearms or 2 ammunition as a method of regulating firearms or ammunition 3 are in conflict with this section and are prohibited. 4 (d) As used in this section, "firearm" means any weapon 5 which will or is designed to expel a projectile by the action 6 7 of an explosive. "Firearm" shall not include any fully 8 automatic weapon or any weapon designed to fire a rocket propelled grenade or any explosive projectile. 9 10 11 6-8-403. Definitions. 12 13 (a) As used in this act: 14 15 (vii) "This act" means W.S. <u>6-8-401</u><u>6-8-402</u> 16 through 6-8-406; 17 18 Section 3. W.S. 6-8-104(t)(iv), (v), (vi), (ix) and (x) 19 is repealed. 20
