**Section 329.**

(a) W.S. 21-13-309(m)(v)(F) is amended to read:

**21-13-309. Determination of amount to be included  
in foundation program for each district.**

(m) In determining the amount to be included in  
the foundation program for each district, the state  
superintendent shall:

(v) Based upon ADM computations and identified  
school configurations within each district pursuant to  
paragraph (iv) of this subsection, compute the  
foundation program amount for each district as  
prescribed by the education resource block grant model  
adopted by the Wyoming legislature as defined under W.S.  
21-13-101(a)(xiv), as contained within the spreadsheets  
and accompanying reports referenced under W.S.  
21-13-101(a)(xvii). The following criteria shall be used  
by the state superintendent in the administration of the  
education resource block grant model:

2 (F) Amounts provided within the model  
3 for health insurance shall be based upon:

5 (I) Prior year statewide average  
6 district weighted actual participation in district  
7 health insurance plans as to the proportion of employee

24 weighted actual participation in district health  
25 insurance plans for the 2018-2019 school year, plus  
26 additional funding for each school district employee  
27 actually enrolled in a school district health insurance  
28 plan in the applicable preceding school year calculated

(3) Additional funding amounts provided to a school district under this subdivision shall be the number of employees calculated under subdivision (1) of this subdivision multiplied by the difference calculated under subdivision (2) of this subdivision."
