22 in farming or ranching and used to dispose of solid waste generated  
23 incidental to his farming and ranching operations;~~or~~

42 (a) As used in this chapter:  
43

1           (vii) "Industrial facility" or "facility" means any  
2 industrial facility with an estimated construction cost of at least  
3 ninety-six million nine hundred thousand dollars (\$96,900,000.00)  
4 as of May 30, 1987. Exempt activities shall not be included in the  
5 estimated construction cost of an industrial facility. The council  
6 shall adjust this amount, up or down, each year using recognized  
7 construction cost indices as the council determines to be relevant  
8 to the actual change in construction cost applicable to the general  
9 type of construction covered under this chapter. "Facility" also  
10 includes, regardless of construction cost:

11  
12           (A) Any commercial waste incineration or disposal  
13 facility capable of receiving greater than five hundred (500) short  
14 tons per day of household refuse or mixed household and industrial  
15 refuse, excluding lands and facilities subject to W.S.
