9-12-1004. Creation of account; collection of annual fee; disposition of proceeds.

 (a) All monies received by the board and office shall be deposited in the state treasury. The state treasurer shall deposit the monies to the credit of the Wyoming tourism account, which is hereby created. Funds in the account are continuously appropriated to the board and office and shall only be expended for the operation of the Wyoming tourism board and the Wyoming office of tourism and to administer this article. Investment earnings on monies in the account shall be deposited to the credit of the account. Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008 or 9-4-207, unexpended funds in the account shall not revert. The board and office shall report the balance of the account each fiscal year to the joint travel, recreation, wildlife and cultural resources interim committee.

(b) The office shall collect an annual fee not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) from all tourism vendors. Fees collected by the office shall be deposited with the state treasurer and credited to the Wyoming tourism account.

9-12-1005. Refund.

(a) Any tourism vendor who has paid any assessment as provided in this article is entitled to a prompt refund of the contribution from the board upon request. A claim for a refund shall be made to the board not less than thirty (30) nor more than ninety (90) days from the date of the payment. The claim shall be made on a form prescribed and furnished by the board.

(b) Before processing any claim for refund under this section, the board may require any additional information or affirmation under penalty of perjury that it deems necessary to determine the validity of the claim.

Section 2. W.S. 9-12-1001(h) and 9-12-1002(a)(intro) are amended to read:

9-12-1001. Wyoming tourism board; creation; composition; appointment; terms; compensation.

(h) For purposes of this article:

(i) "Board" means the Wyoming tourism board;

(ii) "Office" means the Wyoming office of tourism;

(iii) "Tourism vendor" means any person engaged in the business of selling at retail or wholesale tangible personal property, admissions or services that fall under a North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) classification in the sector of arts, entertainment and recreation, sector 71, or accommodation and food services, sector 72.

9-12-1002. General powers and duties of the board; rulemaking authority.

(a) The board shall be responsible for implementing the tourism program and functions assigned to the Wyoming business council under the Wyoming Economic Development Act, including receiving and disbursing funds under W.S. 9-12-1003 through 9-12-1005 and the expenditure of all funds appropriated for the tourism program and shall:".
