Page 2-line 3 Delete "and" and insert ","; after "(viii)"  
insert "and 31-7-119(g)".

Page 2-after line 3 Insert:

**"22-1-102. Definitions.**

(a) The definitions contained in this chapter apply to words  
and phrases used in this Election Code and govern the construction  
of those words and phrases unless they are specifically modified  
by the context in which they appear. As used in this Election Code:

(xxxix) "Acceptable identification" means one (1) of  
the identification documents or other proof of identity as  
specified by rule of the secretary of state as adequate proof of  
the identity of a voter. "Acceptable identification" shall include  
an identification card issued by the department of transportation  
under W.S. 31-8-101;".

Page 4-lines 7 through 15 Delete entirely and insert:

"(a) Acceptable identification shall be required when voting  
in person. Unless a voter is challenged pursuant to W.S. 22-15-  
101 through 22-15-109, no identification shall be required when:

(i) Voting ~~in person or~~ by mail after having registered  
in person; or

(ii) Voting ~~in person or~~ by mail after having registered  
by mail and having previously voted in a Wyoming federal  
election."

Page 14-after line 17 Insert:

**"31-7-119. Expiration and renewal; required tests;  
extension.**

2 (g) The division shall send an application for license  
3 extension pursuant to subsection (f) of this section to the last  
4 known address of an eligible licensee within one hundred twenty  
5 (120) days prior to license expiration. The license extension  
6 application shall be returned to the division with a postmark at  
7 least thirty (30) days prior to the license expiration date. The  
8 application shall be accompanied by written evidence that the  
9 applicant's visual acuity is 20/40 or better with or without  
10 corrective lenses, as tested within one (1) year prior to  
11 submitting the application. Upon receipt of a completed  
12 application and the fee prescribed by W.S. 31-7-113(a)(v), the  
13 division shall issue a license extension to eligible licensees.
