No person under the age of eighteen (18) years shall purchase or attempt to purchase tobacco products, or misrepresent his identity or age, or use any false or altered identification for the purpose of purchasing or attempting to purchase tobacco products. No person under the age of twenty-one (21) years shall purchase or attempt to purchase electronic cigarettes, or misrepresent his identity or age, or use any false or altered identification for the purpose of purchasing or attempting to purchase electronic cigarettes unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age and a member of the military including military veterans, a firefighter as defined in W.S. 27-15-101(a)(i), a volunteer firefighter as defined in W.S. 1-1-125(a)(iii)(B), a peace officer as defined in W.S. 7-2-101(a)(iv) or a tribal law enforcement officer. A person shall not be arrested for an alleged violation of this subsection but shall be issued a citation as a charging document by a peace officer having probable cause to believe the person violated this subsection. An officer issuing a citation shall deposit one (1) copy of the citation with the court having jurisdiction over the alleged offense. Bond may be posted and forfeited for an offense charged under this section in an amount equal to the fine imposed by subsection (b) of this section.

(b) Any person violating subsection (a) of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00).÷".

For inspections relating to electronic cigarettes, the appearance of a person under twenty-one (21) years of age shall not be altered to make him appear to be twenty-one (21) years of age or older;".
