Source of revenue increase:

The animal remedies product registration fee increase.

Assumptions:

This bill would increase the animal remedies product registration fee from \$20 to \$40 and create the Investigator Special Revenue Account (Account). The revenue from the \$20 fee increase would be deposited into the proposed Account.

The Department of Agriculture estimates it will license approximately 1,820 products a year. 1,820 products x \$20 fee increase = \$36,400 annually

This bill is effective immediately. The Department will need to make a one time change to the licensing system and estimated that a total of \$2,000 from the 0900 series will be expended before July 1, 2020. The Department anticipates that their current budget has sufficient funding for the expenditure increase.

The bill would permit the Wyoming Livestock Board (Board) to use special revenue funds to pay for a law enforcement officer. For the 2021-2022 biennium, the Board submitted, and the Governor partially approved, an exception request for an additional law enforcement officer.
