Source of expenditure increase:

Continuation of the Game-Bird Farm certification process beyond the current statute sunset day of December 31, 2022.

## Assumptions:

The Game and Fish Department (Department) administers the Game-Bird Farm certification process for greater sage grouse. To date, this work has resulted in no certification of any greater sage grouse game farms in the state. However, the Department continues to work with one interested proponent. The proposed bill expands the sunset date by seven years to December 31, 2029. Based on work generated to date, and not anticipating additional proponents, this bill would require approximately 200 staff hours each year to monitor the facility and operation of the existing proponent with and estimated cost of \$11,317 annually.

The expenditure increase reflected above could be considered an administrative cost. However, for simplicity and to follow consistent practice on legislation of this type, it is included on the fiscal note.
