1 In addition to any other duties assigned by law, 2 the state superintendent shall: 3 4 (xxxviii) When nonstate funds are received by 5 the department of education that provide for one hundred percent (100%) of the cost, the state superintendent may 6 hire the state school nurse as an at-will contract employee 7 8 or may contract for nursing services to carry out the duties assigned under this paragraph. The state school 9 10 nurse shall hold a Wyoming license as an advanced practice registered nurse. The state school nurse shall: 11 12 (A) Identify professional development needs 13 for Wyoming school nurses, with focus on caring for 14 students with behavioral health needs and chronic diseases 15 and make available training resources to meet the 16 professional development needs identified; 17 18 (B) Assist the superintendent in 19 20 establishing requirements for school district policies and training regarding the use of seclusion and restraint in 21 schools pursuant to paragraph (xxxii) of this subsection; 22

13	needs during the school day;

17	for behavioral health needs, enhance collaboration among

3	<u>issues;</u>

5	(H) In a manner to maintain student
6	confidentiality, collect aggregated data from school
7	districts on medical and behavioral health diagnoses,

9	other nursing challenges that impact schools and students;

11	(J) In consultation with the board of
12	nursing, develop best practice standards for school
13	nursing;

15	(K) At the request of district boards of
16	trustees, advise on the child sexual abuse education,
17	prevention and response program under W.S. 21-3-133.

19	(xxxix) Solicit nonstate funds for costs
20	associated with the position of the state school nurse.
