A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to school finance; limiting transportation  
2 funding for nonresident students as specified; and  
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-13-320(b)(i) is amended to read:

8

9 **21-13-320. Student transportation; amount within**  
10 **school foundation program formula for transportation**  
11 **maintenance and operations expenditures and school bus**  
12 **purchases; district reporting requirements.**

14 (b) There shall be an amount computed for each school  
15 district equal to the base price amount for bus purchase

1 and lease payment expenditures made by the district during  
2 the previous school year pursuant to subsection (g) of this  
3 section and for the amount actually expended by the  
4 district during the previous school year for:

5

6 (i) The maintenance and operation of  
7 transportation routes for transporting school children to  
8 and from school. The amount provided by this paragraph  
9 shall not include expenditures of a school district for  
10 out-of-district mileage attributable to the transportation  
11 of school children who are not residents of the school  
12 district unless the children's school district of residence  
13 has agreed under W.S. 21-4-502 to the children's attendance  
14 in the school district; and

16 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2020.
