2	municipal elections; making conforming amendments;
3	requiring a legislative committee study; and providing for

6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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8	<b>Section 1.</b> W.S. 15-1-107(c), 22-4-304(b) and (c),
9	22-5-301(a), 22-5-304(c), 22-6-117(a) by creating a new
10	paragraph (xi) and renumbering (xi) as (xii), 22-23-102,
11	22-23-202(a)(v)(B), 22-23-301, 22-23-302, 22-23-304,
12	22-23-307(a), 22-23-308(b), 22-23-401 and 22-23-902(a) are
13	amended to read:

15	15-1-107. Vacancies in offices; grounds; how filled.

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(c) If a vacancy is determined to exist, 2 the 3 governing body shall appoint an eligible person from the 4 same political party that the incumbent represented to the office who shall serve until his successor is elected at 5 the next general municipal election and gualified. If the б entire council is vacant, the district judge for the 7 8 district in which the city or town is located shall appoint a person from the same political party that each incumbent 9 10 represented to fill each vacancy and serve until the next 11 general municipal election at which time a successor shall 12 be elected to fill the unexpired portion of each term. 13 14 22-4-304. Certification of candidates; fees. 15 16 (b) The chairman and secretary of the state or county 17 political convention shall certify: 18 19 (i) To the county clerk the names of its party's 20 nominees for elected county offices and office of the 21 district attorney; 22

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1 (ii) To the municipal clerk and county clerk the names of its party's nominees for elected municipal 2 3 <u>offices</u>. 4 5 (c) The names certified to the secretary of state, the municipal clerk or the county clerk shall be filed no 6 7 later than the day before the primary election. 8 9 22-5-301. 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(c) For a municipal or district partisan election, a 5 petition shall be signed by registered electors, resident 6 in the ward, municipality or district and eligible to vote 7 8 for the petitioner, numbering not less than two percent (2%) of the total number of votes cast for the office in 9 10 that particular ward, municipality or district in the last 11 general election. If a ward's municipality's or district's 12 boundaries have changed since the last general election, then the required number of petition signatures shall not 13 be less than two percent (2%) of the number of registered 14 in the current ward, municipality or district 15 voters 16 boundaries at the close of day on the day immediately 17 preceding the primary election.

Municipal officers. 12 All candidates for municipal office shall be nominated at 13 14 the municipal primary election. In order to To be eligible, 15 a candidate must be a registered voter registered in the 16 party whose nomination the candidate seeks and a resident 17 of the municipality and ward which he that the candidate seeks to represent on the day the petition is filed, and 18 19 shall not be an employee of the municipality. As used in 20 this section, the term "employee" includes only those 21 persons receiving an hourly wage or salary from a 22 municipality. A person who provides volunteer services to a municipality shall not be considered an "employee" under 23

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this section based solely upon coverage under the Wyoming 1 Worker's Compensation Act or other pension, death or 2 3 disability program. 4 22-23-302. 2	elected to each office who receive the highest number of
3	votes are nominated to run for the office at the next
4	general election and On each party ballot the candidate or
5	candidates equal in number to the number to be elected to
6	each office who receive the largest number of votes shall
7	be nominated, shall be issued a certificate of nomination
8	by the county clerk and shall be entitled to have their
9	names printed on the ballot for the next general election.
10	A write-in candidate shall not be nominated and shall not
11	be entitled to have his name printed on the ballot for the
12	next general election unless he received at least three (3)
13	votes. An unsuccessful candidate for office at a primary
14	election whose name is printed on any party ballot may not
15	accept nomination for the same office at the next general
16	election.

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(b) A vacancy in nomination shall be filled by the municipal clerk notifying the person who received the next highest number of votes at the municipal primary election as shown on the official county canvass, or, if no other

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1 candidate exists, the vacancy in nomination may be filled 2 from the same political party that the previous office 3 holder represented by the governing body of the 4 municipality. 5 22-23-401. Preparation of ballots; cost. б 7 8 For the municipal general election the county clerk shall prepare ballots which that for municipal officers shall be 9 10 in substantially the same form as the general election 11 nonpartisan ballot for the municipal general election and 12 for municipal ballot propositions shall be as prescribed by law. The name of every candidate legally qualified to 13 appear on the ballot and all municipal ballot propositions 14 to be voted on at the election shall be printed thereon. 15 16 The cost of preparing the municipal ballots shall be 17 determined by the county clerk and paid by the 18 municipality. 19 20 22-23-902.
