1 (i) The following shall apply to the distraint 2 and sale of personal property: 3 4 (B) The following fees, costs and charges shall be collected by the county treasurer to be credited 5 to the county treasury: 6 7 8 Not to exceed twenty dollars (II) $\frac{(\$20.00)}{(\$20.00)}$ two hundred fifty dollars (\\$250.00) 9 10 advertising in the case of sale of personal property. 11 12 (ii) The following shall apply to sales of real 13 property: 14 15 (A) If the county treasurer proceeds to 16 collect delinquent taxes by sale of real property, he shall 17 advertise notice of all sales of real property by publication thereof, once a week for three (3) weeks in a 18 19 legal newspaper in the county, the first publication to be 20 at least two (2) times not less than four (4) weeks prior to the day of sale and prior to the first week in 21 September. If there is no legal newspaper published in the 22 23 county, the county treasurer shall post a written notice of

1 the sale at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of the 2 sale within and near the front door of the courthouse and 3 in three (3) public places in the county in which the major 4 portion of the real property to be sold is situated. In 5 addition to the requirement for newspaper publication or posting of notice under this subparagraph, notice of the 6 sale shall be published in a prominent location on the 7 8 county's website at least four (4) weeks prior to the sale and listed there until after the sale; 9 10 11 (ix) The following fees, costs and charges shall 12 be collected by the county treasurer to be credited to the 13 county treasury: 14 15 Twenty-three cents (\$.23) per mile for (A) 16 necessary travel and not to exceed twenty dollars (\$20.00) 17 two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) for advertising in the case of sale of personal property and not to exceed twenty 18 19 dollars (\$20.00) two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) for 20 advertising in the case of sale of real property to collect 21 delinquent taxes;
