2	(i) There is no longer an on-going duty of
3	support according to subsection (a) of this section;

5	(ii) The obligee, obligor and child, if
6	applicable, produce a written agreement among themselves
7	purporting to settle past support obligations;

9	(iii) The obligor is presently unable to pay;

11	(iv) The obligor currently has no known income
12	or has only nominal income or assets;
13	
14	(v) There is no reasonable prospect that the
15	obligor will be able to pay in the foreseeable future;

17	(vi) The department was given notice as provided
18	under W.S. 20-6-106(e) or arrangement has been made in the
19	parties' written agreement under paragraph (ii) of this
20	subsection for payment of any arrearage assigned to the
21	state of Wyoming.

1 (d) If a court determines that all child support arrearage existing between the parties may be eliminated 2 3 according to subsection (b) or (c) of this section, the 4 court shall enter an order stating that all arrearage has 5 been eliminated. This court order shall satisfy any 6 provision of Wyoming law that requires all arrearage to 7 have been paid. 8 9 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2020. 10
