## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government;
- 2 creating the state budget department; transferring the
- 3 budget division of the department of administration and
- 4 information into the state budget department; requiring a
- 5 reorganization plan; requiring appointment of a director;
- 6 amending members of the financial advisory council; and
- 7 providing for an effective date.

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9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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11 **Section 1**. W.S. 9-2-2021 is created to read:

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9-2-2021. State budget department created; director

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14 appointed; structure.

1 (a) As part of the reorganization of Wyoming state

2 government, there is created the state budget department

3 consisting of the existing budget division of the

4 department of administration and information. Except as

5 otherwise provided in this section, the provisions of the

6 Wyoming Government Reorganization Act of 1989, W.S.

7 9-2-1701 through 9-2-1707, shall apply to this section.

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9 (b) The administrative head of the department shall

10 be a director appointed by the governor with the advice and

11 consent of the senate. Not later than May 1, 2020, the

12 governor shall appoint a director in accordance with W.S.

13 28-12-101(b). Thereafter, appointments for the director of

14 the state budget department shall be in accordance with

15 W.S. 28-12-101 through 28-12-103.

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17 (c) Not later than August 15, 2020, the director

18 shall prepare a plan for reorganization of the agencies,

19 programs and functions specified in this section and submit

20 it to the governor for approval. The director shall include

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21 in the reorganization plan recommendations regarding:

1 (i) Whether the economic analysis division of

2 the department of administration and information should be

3 transferred to the state budget department;

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5 (ii) Necessary modifications to state budgeting

6 statutes and other statutes relating to the duties of the

7 state budget department.

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9 (d) The department reorganization plan, as approved,

10 shall be submitted to the joint appropriations committee

11 and the management audit committee and made available to

12 the public. The committees shall hold at least one (1)

13 public hearing regarding the plan before December 1, 2020.

14 The management audit committee shall report its

15 recommendations on the plan to the joint appropriations

16 committee, including necessary legislation with respect to

17 the plan. The joint appropriations committee shall consider

18 the recommendations and shall report to the legislature not

19 later than December 1, 2020 regarding its recommendations

20 on the plan, including any necessary legislation. The plan,

21 as approved by act of the legislature, shall be implemented

22 not later than July 1, 2021. Pending approval of the plan,

23 the state budget department shall have authority provided

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- 1 by law to the budget division within the department of
- 2 administration and information and shall operate
- 3 independently of the department of administration and
- 4 information.

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- 6 (e) The state budget department shall be subject to
- 7 the direction of the existing administrator of the budget
- 8 division of the department of administration and
- 9 information who shall serve as the director of the state
- 10 budget department until the governor appoints a director in
- 11 accordance with this section.

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- 13 (f) The director of the state budget department shall
- 14 have the authority to:

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- 16 (i) Employ professional, technical and other
- 17 assistants to work in the director's office or in any of
- 18 the divisions, along with other employees necessary to
- 19 carry out the purpose of this act;

- 21 (ii) Adopt reasonable rules and regulations to
- 22 administer this section pursuant to the Wyoming
- 23 Administrative Procedure Act;

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2 (iii) Formulate through his office the policies

3 and programs to be carried out by the department.

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5 (g) The director of the state budget department shall

6 administer through his office all accounting, billing and

7 collection functions required by the department.

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9 (h) The budget division of the department of

10 administration and information is assigned to the state

11 budget department under a Type 1 transfer, effective upon

12 the appointment of a director of the state budget

13 department.

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15 (j) The governor may allocate personnel and other

16 resources between the department of administration and

17 information and the state budget department in accordance

18 with a Type 1 transfer pending approval of the

19 reorganization plan.

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21 **Section 2.** W.S. 9-4-216(a) is amended to read:

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23 9-4-216. Financial advisory council.

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2 (a) There is established a financial advisory council 3 consisting of the state auditor, the state treasurer, the 4 director of the state department of audit, the director of the department of administration and information, the 5 director of the state budget department, the director of 6 7 the department of revenue, a member or designee of the 8 joint appropriation interim appropriations committee, and other persons the governor appoints as ex officio members 9 10 without voting privileges. The state auditor is chairman of

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Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
