

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. SJ0003

Qualifications for University of Wyoming trustee.

A JOINT RESOLUTION

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming
2 Constitution to remove the requirement that a person be a
3 resident of the state of Wyoming to serve as a trustee of the
4 University of Wyoming and limiting the number of nonresidents
5 who may serve as trustees.

7 *BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,*
8 *two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting*
9 *separately, concurring therein:*

11 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming
12 Constitution, Article 7, Section 17 is proposed for
13 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
14 next general election for approval or rejection to become
15 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a majority
16 of the electors at the election:

2 **Article 7, Section 17. Government of university.**

4 The legislature shall provide by law for the management of
5 the university, its lands and other property by a board of
6 trustees, consisting of not less than seven members, to be
7 appointed by the governor by and with the advice and consent
8 of the senate, and the president of the university, and the
9 superintendent of public instruction, as members ex officio,
10 as such having the right to speak, but not to vote. The duties
11 and powers of the trustees shall be prescribed by law. Not
12 more than twenty percent (20%) of the appointed trustees may
13 be nonresidents of the state, notwithstanding the provisions
14 of Article 6, Section 15 of this Constitution.

16 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State shall endorse
17 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

18

19 The adoption of this amendment would allow the governor to
20 appoint nonresidents of the state to serve as University of
21 Wyoming trustees. Not more than twenty percent (20%) of the
22 appointed trustees may be nonresidents of the state. The
23 governor would not be required to appoint any nonresident as

1 a trustee. All appointments to the board of trustees are with
2 the advice and consent of the Wyoming Senate.
