18 **personnel generally; local board of health may fix fees for certain**  
19 **services.**

21 (d) The governing body of a municipality may remove the full-  
22 time or part-time health officer of a municipal health department.  
23 The governing body of a county may remove the full-time or part-  
24 time health officer of a county health department. The governing  
25 bodies of each political subdivision participating in a district  
26 health department may jointly act to remove the full-time or part-  
27 time district health department officer by a majority vote of each  
28 governing body voting separately. The authority provided in this  
29 subsection is in addition to the authority of a local board of  
30 health to remove the full-time or part-time health officer.

32 **35-1-306. Appointment of health officer and other personnel**  
33 **where departments not established; fees and charges for services;**  
34 **payment.**  
35

36 (a) In counties or municipalities where such departments are  
37 not established the boards of county commissioners or municipal  
38 governing body shall appoint the county or municipal health officer  
39 and other necessary personnel. The governing body of any  
40 combination of municipalities, counties, or municipalities and  
41 counties where such departments are not established may form a  
42 health district and appoint a district health officer thereof. The  
43 term of office for the county, municipal, or district health  
44 officer shall be four (4) years unless sooner removed by the board

1 of county commissioners, municipal, or district governing body.  
2 Additionally, the governing bodies of each political subdivision  
3 participating in the district may jointly act to remove a district  
4 health officer by a majority vote of each governing body voting  
5 separately. He shall have a degree of doctor of medicine, and shall  
6 assist the state department of health in carrying out the  
7 provisions of all health and sanitary laws and regulations of the  
8 state.". GRAY
