20 (i) Shall not be subject to arrest or prosecution for
21 violating W.S. 6-4-101 or other criminal acts as a result of
22 engaging in the commercial sex act unless there is probable cause
23 to believe that the minor was not subject to coercion and was not
24 providing forced services when engaging in the act;

26 (ii) Shall be rebuttably presumed to be a victim of human
27 trafficking in any criminal charge as a result of engaging in the
28 commercial sex act, regardless of whether any other person is
29 identified or prosecuted as a result of engaging in the commercial
30 sex act. The presumption shall be overcome only by establishing
31 beyond a reasonable doubt that the minor was not subject to
32 coercion and was not providing forced services when engaging in
33 the commercial sex act.".
