

**FISCAL NOTE**

The fiscal impact to the judicial system is indeterminable due to an unknown number of cases.

The Department of Corrections states that the impact of this bill is indeterminable as there is currently no way to accurately estimate the number of offenders that will be sentenced pursuant to the bill. Currently, there are two inmates incarcerated as a result of a violation of W.S. 6-3-304. The current average annual cost per inmate for incarceration is approximately \$42,340, including medical costs. The current average annual cost per inmate for community supervision is approximately \$2,125 per year. Offenders on supervision are required to pay for their own treatment expenses.
