1 AN ACT relating to supplemental appropriations and reduction of existing 2 appropriations for the operation of state government for the fiscal biennium 3 commencing July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2022; providing definitions; 4 providing for additional appropriations and transfers of funds for the period 5 of the budget; increasing or decreasing certain amounts; adjusting the number 6 of positions; modifying prior appropriations; providing for duties, terms and 7 conditions and other requirements relating to appropriations for the period of 8 the budget as specified; providing for position and other budgetary 9 limitations; requiring agreements between agencies; amending existing law by 10 redirecting revenues and making transfers for the period of the budget; 11 recreating an advisory task force; repealing prior appropriations and budget 12 conditions; and providing for an effective date.

14	Section 339.
15	
16	(a) The Casper state office building advisory task force created in
17	2018 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 136, Section 6 as amended by 2019 Wyoming
18	Session Laws, Chapter 205, Section 4 is hereby recreated.
19	
20	(b) The task force shall be comprised of:
21	
22	(i) Four (4) members of the legislature as follows:
23	
24	(A) Two (2) members of the senate, appointed by the
25	president of the senate;
26	
27	(B) Two (2) members of the house of representatives,
28	appointed by the speaker of the house.

1	
2	(ii) Five (5) members appointed by the governor to include:
3	
4	(A) One (1) member from the state construction department;
5	
6	(B) One (1) member to represent the interests of the city
7	<u>of Casper;</u>
8	
9	(C) One (1) member to represent the interests of the Casper
10	downtown development authority;
11	
12	(D) Two (2) members appointed from the state agencies that
13	are anticipated to occupy the Casper state office building.
14	
15	(c) The cochairmen of the task force shall be appointed by the
16	president of the senate and the speaker of the house, respectively.
17	
18	(d) The task force shall serve in an advisory role and provide
19	recommendations to the executive branch of government for the procurement of
20	professional services and construction and completion of the Casper state
21	office building project. While serving in an advisory role, the task force
22	shall:
23	
24	(i) Receive and, when necessary, request information from the
25	state construction department to stay informed on all aspects of the Casper
26	state office building project;
27	

1	(ii) Closely monitor the procurement of professional services and
2	progress on the Casper state office building project;
3	
4	(iii) When necessary or prudent, make recommendations to the
5	state construction department regarding important aspects of the Casper state
6	office building project;
7	
8	(iv) Closely monitor and make recommendations to the state
9	construction department and any entity procured for professional services on
10	all aspects of the meeting rooms and facilities located within the Casper
11	state office building project that are designed to accommodate meetings of
12	joint interim committees of the legislature in accordance with 2018 Wyoming
13	Session Laws, Chapter 136, Section 6(k) as amended by 2019 Wyoming Session
14	Laws, Chapter 205, Section 4;
15	
16	(v) Provide interim reports on the activities of the task force
17	to the joint appropriations committee not later than November 1, 2021;
18	
19	(vi) Include in each interim report the status of the meeting
20	rooms and facilities referenced in paragraph (iv) of this subsection and any
21	recommendations for legislative action that should be considered during the
22	legislative session immediately following the report as necessary to continue
23	or complete the Casper state office building project.
24	
25	(e) The task force shall be staffed by the state construction
26	department with assistance provided by the legislative service office. In
27	staffing the task force, the state construction department shall:
28	

1	(i) Coordinate and schedule all meetings, assemble all required
2	meeting agenda and meeting materials for the task force and include and
3	communicate with the legislative service office to allow the legislative
4	service office to provide sufficient assistance to the legislative members to
5	fulfill their responsibilities as members of the task force;
6	
7	(ii) Act as a liaison between the task force and the executive
8	branch of government to communicate task force recommendations;
9	
10	(iii) Provide regular updates and progress reports to the task
11	force and the state building commission concerning the Casper state office
12	building project;
13	
14	(iv) Provide other information and assistance to the task force
15	as requested.
16	
17	(f) Members of the task force who are legislators shall be paid salary,
18	per diem and mileage in the amount and manner provided for members of an
19	interim committee under W.S. 28-5-101 and 28-5-102 when performing official
20	duties as members of the task force. The cochairmen of the task force shall be
21	eligible for salary as provided under W.S. 28-5-101(e)(i).
22	
23	(g) Except as otherwise provided in this section, nonlegislative
24	members of the test force shall serve without colory but shall be paid

8	This appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of funding salary,
9	mileage and per diem of legislative members of the task force. Notwithstanding
10	any other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be transferred or
11	expended for any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining
12	from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2022.
13	
14	(k) There is appropriated ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) from the
15	strategic investments and projects account to the state construction
16	department. This appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of
17	funding mileage and per diem for the members of the task force appointed by
18	the governor who are not state employees. Notwithstanding any other provision
19	of law, this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other
20	purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this
21	appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2022.
22	
23	(m) If legislation creating substantially the same task force as
24	created by this section is enacted into law in the 2021 General Session, this
25	section shall not be effective.
