2 (a) A current or former journalist shall have a 3 privilege to refuse to disclose and to prevent the 4 disclosure of any information obtained or received in 5 confidence or the identity of the source of the information 6 if the journalist:

8 (i) Obtains or receives the information, with or 9 without solicitation, in the course of gathering or obtaining news for publication in or with a newspaper, 10 11 magazine, news media, press association, wire service, 12 website or other professional medium or agency that has as 13 one of its principal functions the processing and 14 researching of news intended for publication or for broadcast by a radio station or television network; and 15 16

(ii) When the information was obtained or received, was employed by or was otherwise in a news gathering capacity with a newspaper, magazine, news media, press association, wire service, website, radio station, television network or other professional medium or agency.
