

## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0156

Twenty-four hour wine permits.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to alcoholic beverages; establishing a  
2 twenty-four hour permit for winery permit holders to sell  
3 their manufactured wine off-premises; authorizing fees; and  
4 providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-4-414, as created by 2021 House  
9 Bill 0013, by creating a new subsection (g) is amended to  
10 read:

12 **12-4-414. Winery permits; authorized; conditions;**  
13 **satellite winery permits; direct shipment of wine; fees;**  
14 **off-premises permits.**

1       (g) The local licensing authority may issue to a  
2 winery permit holder an off-premises wine permit for the  
3 purpose of selling its own manufactured wine at meetings,  
4 conventions, private parties, dinners and other similar  
5 gatherings to promote the holder's product. No permittee  
6 holding an off-premises wine permit shall sell or permit  
7 consumption of any of their manufactured product off the  
8 premises described in the permit. An off-premises wine  
9 permit shall be issued for one (1) twenty-four (24) hour  
10 period, subject to the schedule of operating hours set  
11 pursuant to W.S. 12-5-101. No holder of a wine permit shall  
12 receive more than twelve (12) off-premises wine permits in  
13 any one (1) calendar year. An off-premises wine permit may  
14 be issued on application to the appropriate licensing  
15 authority. The local licensing authority may require  
16 payment of an additional permit fee of not less than ten  
17 dollars (\$10.00) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) per  
18 twenty-four (24) hour period.

20       **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2021.
