- 12 (a) The Wyoming liquor division shall purchase and
- 13 sell alcoholic liquors to qualified licensees within the
- 14 state including, at the discretion of the division, any
- 15 retail distributors or permittees operating within any

the

1 military post or national park located within the 2 boundaries of the state of Wyoming. Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, sales shall be made at 3 4 prices sufficient to return the cost of merchandise and all 5 expenses of operation together with a profit, not to exceed 6 seventeen and six-tenths percent (17.6%) twenty and 7 <u>six-tenths</u> <u>percent</u> (20.6%) above the cost of 8 merchandise. 9
