AN ACT relating to the Wyoming national guard; providing 1 legislative findings; prohibiting the release of the 2 3 Wyoming national guard into active combat as specified; and 4 providing for an effective date. 5 б Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 7 Section 1. The Wyoming legislature finds that the 8 9 Defend The Guard Act follows the principles embodied in the 10 United States Constitution and the writings of the 11 Article I, section 8, of the United States founders. 12 constitution vests in the congress the exclusive power to

declare war. By abdicating the war powers to the executive

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branch, the United States congress has failed to follow the 1 2 United States constitution and the intent of the founders. 3 Section 2. W.S. 19-9-104 is created to read: 4 5 19-9-104. Defend the guard act. 6 7 8 (a) This section shall be known and may be cited as the "Defend the Guard Act". 9 10 11 (b) For the purposes of this section: 12 13 (i) "Active duty combat" means performing the following services in the active federal military service 14 of the United States: 15 16 17 (A) Participation in an armed conflict; 18 19 (B) Performance of a hazardous service 20 relating to an armed conflict in a foreign state; or 21 22 (C) Performance of a duty through an instrumentality of war. 23

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2 (ii) "Official declaration of war" means an 3 official declaration of war made by the United States 4 congress pursuant to article I, section 8, clause 11 of the 5 United States constitution.

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7 (c) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the 8 Wyoming national guard and any member thereof shall not be released from the state into active duty combat unless the 9 10 United States congress has passed an official declaration 11 of war or has taken an official action pursuant to article 12 I, section 8, clause 15 of the United States constitution to explicitly call forth the Wyoming national guard and any 13 member thereof for the enumerated purposes to expressly 14 execute the laws of the union, repel invasion or suppress 15 16 insurrection. The governor shall take all actions an 17 necessary to comply with the requirements of this section.

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(d) Nothing in this section limits or prohibits the governor from consenting to the deployment of any Wyoming national guard member under title 32 of the United States code for the purpose of defense support for civil authority

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    missions within the United States and United States
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  territories.

    the state may be ordered into the service of the United
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    States by the president of the United States for any
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    purpose for which he is authorized to use militia of the
