Closing or restricting use; failure to 10 observe signs and markers; exceptions. 11 12 (a) Any person who willfully fails to observe any 13 sign, marker, warning, notice, or direction, placed or 14 given under W.S. 24-1-108 is guilty of a misdemeanor, and 15 upon conviction thereof by any court of competent

jurisdiction, shall be subject to a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) or to imprisonment for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days, or to both such fine and imprisonment. **Section 2**. This act is effective July 1, 2021. (END)
