An elector requesting a major party ballot must declare his 1 2 party affiliation in accordance with W.S. 22-5-214, or sign 3 an application for change of affiliation before he may 4 receive a party ballot. An elector may vote only the nonpartisan ballot and if so, is not required to declare 5 б his party affiliation. Requesting a partisan primary election ballot constitutes a declaration of party 7 affiliation. A change in declaration of party affiliation 8 shall be in accordance with the requirements of W.S. 9 10 22-5-214 and shall be entered on the poll list by the election judge. 11 12 13 22-5-214. Change in party affiliation. 14 (a) For a primary election, an elector may change his 15 party affiliation by completing an application signed 16 before a notarial officer or election official and filing 17 it with the county clerk on or before May 1st preceding the 18 19 primary election. 20 21 (b) For a general election, an elector may change his party affiliation by completing an application signed 22

23 before a notarial officer or election official, and filing
