9 **Section 1**. W.S. 37-9-506 is created to read:

11 37-9-506. Railroad train crews.

13 (a) No railroad train or light engine used in a class

14 one (1) railroad, as defined by the surface transportation

- 1 connection with the movement of freight shall be operated
- 2 in this state unless the train has a crew of at least two
- 3 (2) individuals.

- 5 (b) Any railroad company, corporation or employer who
- 6 willfully violates subsection (a) of this section shall be
- 7 guilty of a misdemeanor and fined:

- 9 (i) Not less than two hundred fifty dollars
- 10 (\$250.00) nor more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00)
- 11 for a first offense;

- 13 (ii) Not less than one thousand dollars
- 14 (\$1,000.00) nor more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00)
- 15 for a second offense committed within three (3) years;

- 17 (iii) Not less than five thousand dollars
- 18 (\$5,000.00) nor more than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00)
- 19 for a third or subsequent offense committed within three
- 20 (3) years.
