(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law and 1 2 subject to subsection (c) of this section, a business 3 entity may represent itself without an attorney in any 4 proceedings under this article that the business entity 5 commences or is required to respond to or participate in, provided that: 6 7 8 (i) The business entity is represented by an owner, shareholder, member, partner or other employee of 9 10 the business entity; 11 12 (ii) The person representing the business entity may litigate actions on behalf of themselves without an 13 attorney, provided that if an attorney appears, the 14 opposing party is entitled to a continuance for the purpose 15 16 of obtaining an attorney of its own;

(iii) The business entity provides notice in writing to the court, the state bar and all other parties to the proceedings that it is being represented by an owner, shareholder, member, partner or other employee of the business entity who is not an attorney.

2 rule, any person who represents a business entity in an

3 action or proceeding under this article in accordance with

4 the provisions of this section shall not be deemed to have

5 engaged in the unauthorized practice of law, provided that
