9 "**31-2-214. Transfer of ownership.**

11 (a) Except as provided by subsections (b) through (d) of
12 this section, upon transfer of ownership of a vehicle the
13 registration of the vehicle expires and the original owner shall
14 immediately remove the license plates from the vehicle. Within
15 sixty (60) days after acquiring another vehicle for which the
16 license plates would be proper, the original owner may file an
17 application for the transfer of the license registration number to
18 a vehicle acquired by him accompanied by the fees based on the
19 amount which would be due on a new registration as of the date of
20 transfer less any credit for the unused portion of the original
21 registration fees for the original vehicle for the assignment of
22 the plates to the recently acquired vehicle subject to the
23 following:

25 (ii) The state fee shall be calculated by multiplying
26 the amount prescribed by W.S. 31-3-101(a)(ii) times the number of
27 full months remaining in the registration year divided by twelve
28 (12) and rounding to the next highest dollar. For utility trailers
29 permanently registered under W.S. 31-2-206(n), the state fee shall
30 be the amount that would be due under a new registration as of the
31 date of the transfer less a credit for fees paid under W.S. 31-2-
32 206(n);

34 (b) Upon transfer of ownership of a vehicle held in joint
35 ownership between two (2) or more of the joint owners, or by a
36 person to the person's spouse, child, brother, sister or parent,
37 upon application and payment of the proper fee, the county
38 treasurer shall issue a new registration reflecting the changed
39 ownership and cancel the previous registration. The vehicle may
40 then be operated with the same license plates for the remainder of
41 the registration ~~year~~term." . KOST
